○ **Taxi or Travel information for Airport**

- Taxi one way from Miami International Airport \$32.00 total (not per person)
- Taxi one way from Ft. Lauderdale International Airport \$70.00
- Blue Shuttle Service \$21.00 per person 1-877-300-4VAN (4826)

○ **Tip Recommendations**

- Tip Recommendations for Valet \$2.00
- Frequent in and out valet should tip AM and PM shift
- Bellmen Tip for luggage pull per room \$5.00
- Tip Recommendations for Housekeeping at the end of stay \$10.00

○ **Room information**

- To call from room to room Dial 7 before any 3 digit room
- There is internet in each room. However, there is a fee. \$12.00 per day, \$50 per week.
- Coin Washers and Dryers are on every floor by elevators for public use
- All room service orders will need to be cash orders only per THS and the hotel
- All restaurants on the property have been told not to charge any food to the rooms per THS and the hotel.
- Any movie rentals in the rooms will need to be cash payments only.

○ **Bus/Parking Information**

- Daily Bus Schedule will be located on Mezzanine Level for players/parents to view (2nd floor)
- Coaches sign up schedule for other events / travel will be located outside room 501.
- There is a public parking lot a block from the hotel that is metered during the day but free from 6pm-7am, so this might be a good alternative if you need other parking besides valet.
- All other parking at the hotel is valet only and that is \$30.00 a day.

○ **Suggestions of Areas to visit/eat (many of which the bus will be scheduled to visit). Recommended by Concierge and our contact person at hotel**

- Malls are Lincoln Road, Bayside Market Place (where cruise ships come into), and Aventura (bus will go to one of these places on different days)
- Lincoln Road is on 17th street, and the Miami Convention center is on 19th Street. There are all kinds of restaurants and shops here that are 2 blocks from the convention center. If you play in the morning, it might be a great idea to eat right after you finish playing and then head back to the hotel for the remainder of the evening and get call in orders or delivery later that night.
- Sopranos Restaurant - will pick you up in a limo at no extra cost. \$25-\$35 per person for meals.
- Ocean Drive - was also highly recommended for eating and shopping.

○ **Pool / Beach**

- There are two pools on the property and an outside bar/cabana. The pools are fairly shaded.
- The beach is just out the back gate of the property and very nice. There are chairs and umbrellas also for rent.
